Thomas Hatch provided an operations update which included both national and program specific account enrollments, Assets Under Management (AUM), and average account size. He highlighted the impressive grow in AUM for the calendar year of 2023.

Alaina Bowers provided copies of the new account, asset and outreach maps. She highlighted some upcoming work on testimonial videos and other scheduled outreach events in the current quarter.

Andrea Feirstein presented a slide deck of national comparisons on a variety of topics. These included such topics as national growth, program structure, account and asset growth over time, fee comparisons and some legislative items to consider moving forward.

There was a robust discussion amongst committee members about Medicaid payback and it's hinderance to account growth. Thoughts were shared about pursuit of legislative change.
